As the school was preparing for the new term this year the Ugandan education authorities requested more living space be provided for the boys of Primary school age. The school relies on gaining a license from the government in order to operate, so this request had to be taken seriously. As the children get older they need additional living space so at the beginning of January the extra land purchased this time last year was turned into a building site and ground works were started on a new dormitory block.



The school has gained its license and can open while the work proceeds and it is hoped that it will not be too long before the children move into the newly completed building and enjoy more spacious accommodation.



The generous donation received in October from the “Without Limits” conference was put to good use and provided a large number of mosquito nets which were given to the children and young people who live permanently at the school. Also thank you to everyone who made a donation so these students could enjoy something extra to eat at Christmas.

Plans are coming together for what has become the annual springtime fundraising night. This will be on Friday April 28th at 7.30pm in The King's Church, Thornton. Supper will be a traditional Uganda dish which Maxene Kidman and her team will prepare, and "yes" there will be Matoke on the menu for those who have heard about it but have yet to taste it. Live music will come from the ukulele band No Strings Attached and Eddie and the Parrots. Tickets will be available shortly from the trustees.



It is hoped that the money raised on the night can be used to improve the Medical Centre building and the quality of medical and healthcare provided at the school. The purchase of the testing equipment needed for the early identification and treatment of malaria is also a main priority.
