The school reopened in January after the Christmas holidays and successfully passed an inspection by the Ugandan Ministry of Education. During the holidays some students acquired new skills such as painting, decorating and also brick making. There has been an extensive



programme to upgrade the interior of the classrooms and dormitories with a lot of plastering and painting taking place. The new toilet blocks for the girls and boys have been plumbed in and the kitchen facilities have been extended.

Progress has been made on the creation of a Medical Centre and there are now two wards, the one for boys is shown on the right, and there is another ward for girls. Each ward contains three hospital style beds and the nurse now has a new examination couch and improved storage for medical items. More is needed to be done before a good level of medical care can be provided as a variety of medical equipment is still required.



It was not possible for any of the trustees to visit the school in 2017 but a visit will take place this year once a date can be finalised and at a time that coincides with Annet returning home. It is hoped to take out T shirts and medical items as has been the case in previous years.

The trustees would like to thank Gretchen Carlson and her church in Minnesota, USA who has set up a project titled 360 Vision for Africa as a means to promote the New Hope Child Sponsorship programme.



The aim is to find sponsors who will donate \$30/ month, (hence 360). It is nearly 12 months since Gretchen first had the desire to support New Hope in this way and through hard work and persistence she now has a core group of supporters to work with her. As an offshoot, Annet has the opportunity for the New Hope Foundation to apply for financial support to the International Ministerial Fellowship, an organisation in Minnesota that supports Christian Ministries.

There are some dates you might like to note in your diaries. On Saturday 14th April at 7.30pm at The King's Church, 2 Drummond Road, Thornton, Liverpool L23 9YP there will be what has become an annual fundraising night and an evening of live music. Annet is still receiving cancer treatment in the USA and her condition remains stable. She will begin a different course of chemotherapy shortly in the hope of shrinking the tumour; she hopes to be able to return home soon.

It is vital that this does not happen as the trustees want every penny that you donate to go to the school and not taken by the bank.
